Eagles' Kindness Project Mr. Bryon Mane, Coretta Scott King Magnet

Principal Mr. Bryon Mane presented the CSK *Eagle's Kindness Project* at this month's board meeting. Mr. Mane explained that the project asked students to go out and "Find the good in our world!" by searching for people performing acts of kindness. Each time they found someone receiving an act of kindness, they presented them with a paper eagle. The eagle asked the person to report the act of kindness via hashtag link, email, letter, or QR Code.

Additionally, students were asked to send a CSK Kindness Global Eagle to a friend or family member in another state or country to also help sight and recognize kindness. Remarkably, the students began receiving "kindness sighting" reports from nine different states (i.e. California, Texas, Oklahoma, Missouri, Nevada, Illinois, Indiana, Alabama, and Tennessee) and four foreign countries (i.e. Canada, Malaysia, Greenland, and Greece). Members of the school board congratulated Mr. Mane and his Eagles' on the important and timely project. "It could not have come and a better time," remarked board member Mrs. Gasbarro.
