## Graduation Rehearsal

**Wednesday, May 30**

Commencement is a very important event in a student's life. To be certain that the line-up, seating arrangements, and the diploma awarding ceremony are clearly understood and orderly, a **MANDATORY rehearsal will take place on Wednesday, May 30, beginning promptly at 9:00 a.m.** in the Field House. Seniors must be on time and remain for the entire rehearsal in order to participate in the ceremony. **NO Exceptions!**

## SPECIAL ANNOUNCEMENTS from FOOD SERVICE:



- The Food Services Department will email fee statements on April 27 to the email address they have on file. Please be sure to check your food service balance on *Family Access* to **avoid delay** in receiving graduation tickets.
- Due to federal guidelines, **payments for Food Service fees MUST be paid directly to Food Service staff.** Your student may make a payment during their lunch mod OR you may pay online using E-funds. For your convenience, the Food Service office will also be open on May 1 (8 a.m. to 10 a.m.) to receive payments. **CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS ARE NOT ACCEPTED.**
- The **LAST DAY to charge money** to your senior's food service account is **April 27.** After this date, they must use cash to purchase breakfast or lunch.

## Graduation Tickets



Each graduating & participating senior will receive **three (3) tickets** for admission to the ceremony which are numbered and assigned to the graduate. No additional tickets are available. Tickets will be distributed on **Wednesday, May 30**, immediately following rehearsal.

**PLEASE NOTE: All fees must be PAID IN FULL to receive tickets.**

## Bonus Ticket

Seniors may receive **one (1) Bonus Ticket** for admission to the **Live Broadcast in the Auditorium** if all fees are **PAID IN FULL** by the end of the school day on **Tuesday, May 1, 2018.** This ticket will be **BLUE** in color. *Because of limited space in the Gymnasium, we are only able to accommodate additional guests in the auditorium.*

Guests with the Bonus Ticket must enter through the Milton E. Payton Auditorium entrance.

Only those students who have **achieved required credit hours AND are passing all course requirements** as of **Wednesday, May 23, 2018**, will participate in the graduation ceremony.

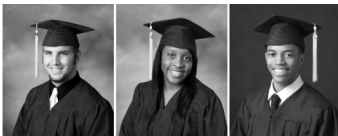

### Social Suspension

Marching in the graduation ceremony is a privilege. Seniors on social suspension at the end of the year will not be allowed to participate in the ceremony.

### Dress Code

- Graduates must have their cap, gown, tassel, medallion, cords, etc., and must wear the prescribed gown **without** modification.
- Caps must be worn with the point in the center of the forehead and the tassel on the right side of the cap. The top of the cap should be level. **No LETTERING OR MODIFICATION MAY BE ADDED TO THE CAP.**
- Appropriate and respectable clothing should be worn under gowns:
  - \* Men: Shirt and slacks (tie optional)
  - \* Ladies: Dress, skirt, or slacks
- Gowns **MUST** be zipped.
- **Flip flops, sneakers, and gum chewing are prohibited.**



### Graduation Day

- **Seniors should arrive no later than 6:00 p.m.**, park in the east lot, and report to the Field House. Please enter through Door #8.
- **Guest Parking:** Ample parking will be available on the east side of the high school. **Handicapped parking** will be available on a first come first serve basis in the front circle drive parking lot.
- **Guests** with a **GOLD TICKET** should enter through the Athletic entrance located in the front of the school. Doors will open at 6:15 p.m.
- **Guests** with a **BLUE TICKET** should enter through the Auditorium entrance located in the front of the school. Doors will open at 6:15 p.m.
- **The ceremony will begin promptly at 7:00 p.m.** Once the processional begins, we will hold admittance until all graduates have entered the gymnasium.

### General Information

- **VALUABLES:** All valuables should be left at home. CMHS is not responsible for articles left in the Field House during the ceremony.
- **FLOWERS, BALLOONS, AND/OR GIFTS:** Due to limited space in the gymnasium and to not block the view of others, flowers, balloons, and/or gifts **WILL NOT** be allowed in the building.
- **CELL PHONES:** Seniors are not allowed to have cell phones turned on during the graduation rehearsal **OR** at the ceremony. Students found using their cell phones will be removed. Parents are also asked to silence/turn off cell phones during the ceremony.
- **HANDICAPPED SEATING:** If you need to reserve handicapped seating for a ticketed guest, please contact Ms. Rodriguez by email or phone at [rodriguezcm201u.org](mailto:rodriguezcm201u.org) or 708-367-8230 by **May 15**. Due to limited space, only the handicapped guest will be allowed to be seated in this section. Family members may sit behind them, space permitting.
- **DIPLOMA PICK-UP:** Graduates are to proceed to the Field House immediately after the ceremony to pick-up their diplomas.

### Decorum

The graduation ceremony is a formal event and it is an expectation that the decorum reflects such an atmosphere.
